Advisors are also available during this time period on a Drop-In basis to discuss the same topics in the Advising Center. The Center is open Monday – Thursday, 8:00 – 7:00, and 8:00 – 5:00 on Fridays. You must be signed in 30 minutes prior to closing and must have a current Advising Report (no older than 48 hours to be signed in) that can be obtained from eConnect online or from the Admissions counter. Both Admissions & Advising are located in Thunderduck Hall.

**Group Advising Only** (no individual advising sessions):

April 17 – 27, 2012

June 12 – August 25, 2012

**First Time In College** students Spring, 2012 with a First Time in College Advising block (AV) [denoted near the top of the Advising report as a Restriction] will be allowed to register on campus beginning 4/17/12. However, your AV block will not be removed, allowing you to register online, until you have attended a First Time In College session. See below for the First Time In College group session times. If your schedule does not permit your attendance at one of the group sessions, please make an appointment with an advisor for an individual appointment or drop-in to the Advising Center no later than Thursday, April 5, 2012.

## **Registration Dates**

### **May Term, Summer I, and Summer II**

**April 17, 2012:**

Registration begins for Continuing students **ONLY**. Continuing students are students that have attended any DCCCD college within the last 12 months.

**April 23, 2012:**

Registration begins for New, Former (any student that has not attended a DCCCD college within the last 12 months), and Transfer students.

**May Term Registration Deadline:**

In person & online: **Monday, 5/14/12** for students in Good Academic Standing. This is the first day of class. Students can continue to register as long as the class has not met. **PLEASE NOTE:** Only one May Term class is allowed.

Students with a GPA below 2.0 may be restricted from taking May Term classes. You must have met with an advisor and be registered for May Term classes no later than **Friday, May 4, 2012.**

#### **Summer I Registration Deadline:**

In person & online: **Wednesday 6/6/12** for students in Good Academic Standing. This is the first day of class. Students can continue to register as long as the class has not met.

Students with a GPA below 2.0 must have met with an advisor and be registered for Summer I classes no later than **Friday, May, 25, 2012 by 4:00 pm.**

#### **Summer II Registration Deadline:**

In person & online: **Monday 7/9/12** for students in Good Academic Standing. This is the first day of class. Students can continue to register as long as the class has not met.

Students with a GPA below 2.0 must have met with an advisor and be registered for Summer II classes no later than **Friday, June, 22, 2012 by 4:00 pm.**

### **Registration Dates**

#### **Fall 2012**

##### **June 12, 2012:**

Fall registration begins for continuing students **ONLY**. Continuing students are students that have attended any DCCCD college within the last 12 months.

##### **June 18, 2012:**

Fall registration begins for new, former (any student that has not attended a DCCCD college within the last 12 months), and transfer students.

#### **Fall Registration Deadlines:**

In person & online: **Monday, 8/27/12** for students in Good Academic Standing. This is the first day of class. Students can continue to register as long as the class has not met.

Students with a GPA below a 2.0 with an Advising block (AV) [denoted near the top of the Advising report as a Restriction] **MUST** be registered by **4:00 pm on Friday, 7/27/12**. Students who miss this deadline **MUST** contact their advisor for possible registration options.

Students with a GPA below a 2.0 with no existing AV block see below for registration deadlines:

**PLEASE NOTE: FINANCIAL AID WILL NOT PAY FOR ANY CLASSES REGISTERED AFTER 9/11/12.]**

#### **Students on Probation 1 with a gpa of 1.0 or above with no existing AV block:**

are limited to taking a maximum of 2 classes and must be registered by Saturday, August 25. Hours of operation on this Saturday are 10:00am – 4:00 pm, **BUT** students must be signed in to see an advisor by 3:30 pm.

#### **Students on Probation 1 with a gpa below a 1.00 with no existing AV block:**

**Students on Probation 2 & 3, Suspension, Dismissal, and Indefinite Dismissal with no existing AV block:**

**No student with a GPA below 2.0 will be allowed to register for regular semester classes after Saturday, 8/25/12.**

**PLEASE NOTE: It is the responsibility of the student to meet payment deadlines. Payment plans are available if Financial Aid is not fully processed and showing on the Registration Summary on day of registration. If classes are dropped for lack of payment, student is still responsible for meeting above noted deadlines. Exceptions past registration deadlines above will not be made for students who miss payment deadlines and/or Financial Aid has not paid for classes by payment due date.**
