



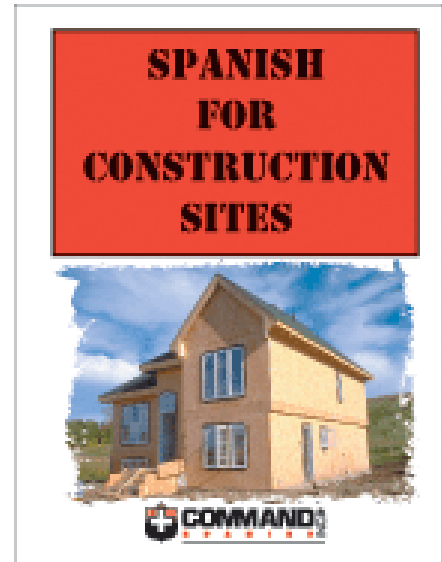
Spanish for Construction Sites
