Rudy Carrillo began the meeting by distributing the agenda and related attachments. The agenda items included (1) Ask Me Tables, (2) Grow Beyond the Tables, (3) Teacher of the Month, (4) Potential Projects by Linda Steele, and (5) Update on E070/E076 Renovation Project.

Council members discussed the status of the Ask Me Information Tables for the start of Spring 2004. Rudy suggested that Melinda Weaver, Fillis Hughes, Delfina Bedarte, and Joe Perea co-chair the Ask Me Tables for Spring 2004.

Gwen May discussed her thoughts on extending the idea of the Ask Me Tables to include registration assignments for college personnel that reflect Richland's spirit, community and hospitality to our students, campus tours conducted by the Richland Connections Club, and Richland retirees working the lines during registration.

Dwight Riley and Brent Donham submitted the 'BEST IN CLASS' RECOGNITION PROGRAM - a Focus on Best Practices for Teaching and Learning (see attached). More details will be presented at the next meeting.

Linda Steele presented three potential projects including: (1) an adjunct mentor program, (2) a section in the Richland Chronicle that profiles adjuncts and faculty, and (3) a lecture/discussion series just for teachers. The council will discuss these items at our next meeting.
