Dallas Independent School District – Dallas County Community College District

These college courses are available to Dallas Independent School District students for high school dual credit. Each high school must work with the Dallas ISD and DCCCD dual credit coordinators to determine which courses will be offered on their high school campus. Some high school courses require the completion of two (or more) college courses in order for high school credit to be awarded. DC following a high school course title indicates a dual credit designated course number. Students at one of the Early College High Schools or Middle College should work with their high school counselor and follow Matrix C.

Physical Education. High schools will transcript the high school course and add "D" for dual credit in the course code when student provides college transcript showing successful completion of the course. A Dallas ISD PE course number can be used once and only for the semester designated. (ie: If PHED 1116 Conditioning Exercise is taken during a spring semester, then 4815 Aerobic Activities (Spr) would not be used at any other time for a spring Aerobic Activities course. For students desiring to take a spring semester PE class, 4821 Foundations of Personal Fitness (Spr) or 4812 Individual/Team Sports (Spr) could be taken. <i>* PHED 1164 is the college course that will transfer to a four-year university.</i> PHED course offerings may vary among the seven DCCCD campuses. Verify that the PHED course a student wants to take is being offered at the DCCCD campus the student will be attending. <u>Students are not able to substitute PHED courses not listed on the matrix for dual credit.</u>

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) limits high school students to two college courses for dual credit per semester unless approved by high school principal and college president or designee. Dallas County Community College District (DCCCD) course name and number could change as required by THECB. Changes in course content will require realignment of the high school and college courses.
