

Richland College 2008-09 Graduate Profile

- 1,006 graduates with 919 associate degrees and 221 certificates
- 36% Anglo, 17% African-American, 22% Hispanic and 16% Asian (see figure 1)
- Most graduates completed within 2 to 4 years, however, because of outliers the average completion time was 7 years
- 86% of associate degree earners also completed the DCCCD core curriculum
- With the exception of the Asian student segment, females graduated in higher numbers than males for all ethnic groups (see figure 2)
- Ninety percent of graduates took at least one day class, 74% took at least one class taught via distance learning, 69% took at least one flex class, and 67% took at least one evening class (see figure 3)
- Classes offered in fasttrack format were the least often taken by the 2008-09 graduates (see figure 3)
- Sixty-seven percent of graduates took one or more developmental courses (see figure 4)
- Of those graduates taking developmental courses, 95% took developmental mathematics (see figure 5)
- Fifty-five percent of the 2008-09 graduates were under the age of 25
- Fifty-three percent of the 2008-09 graduates received some type of financial aid

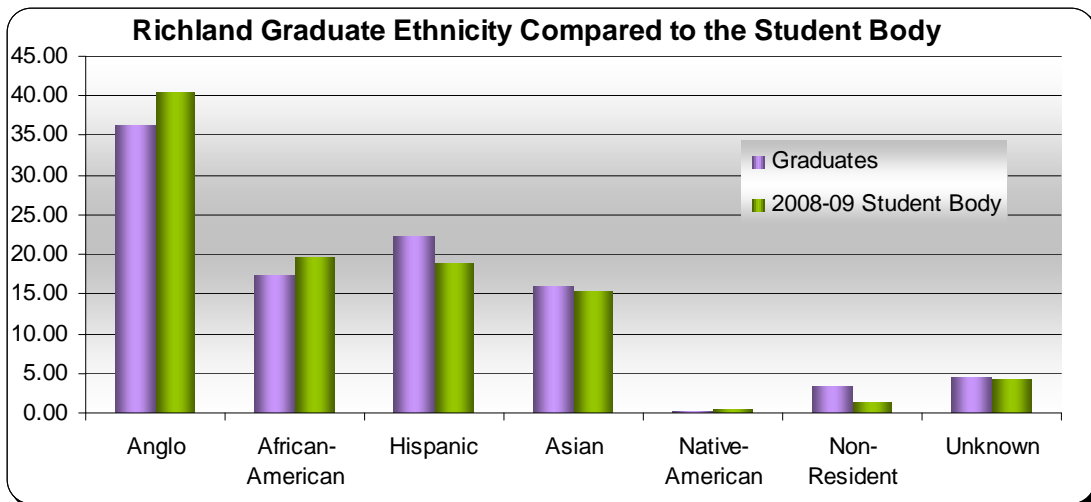

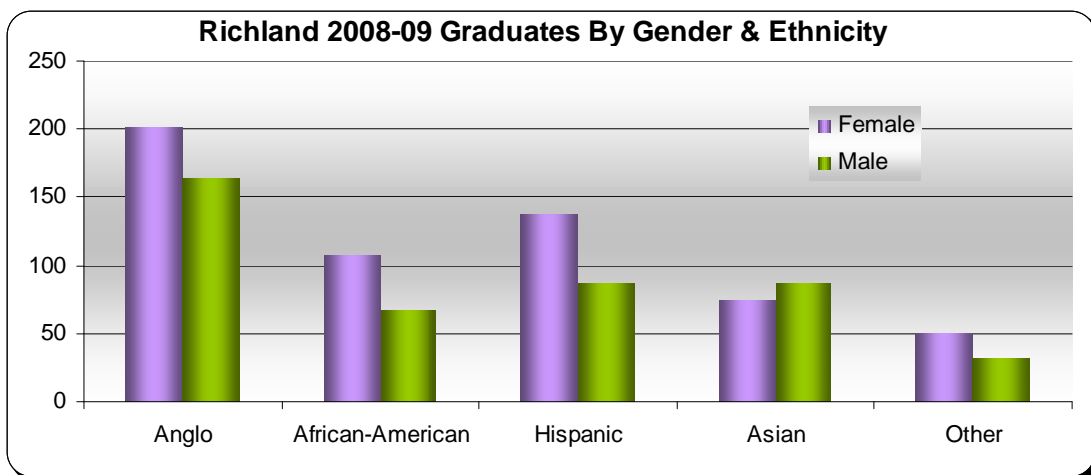

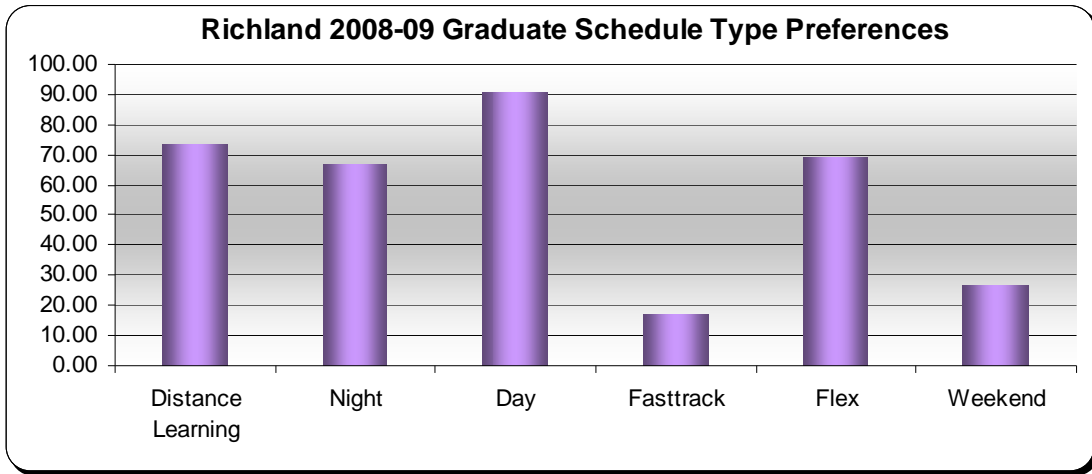

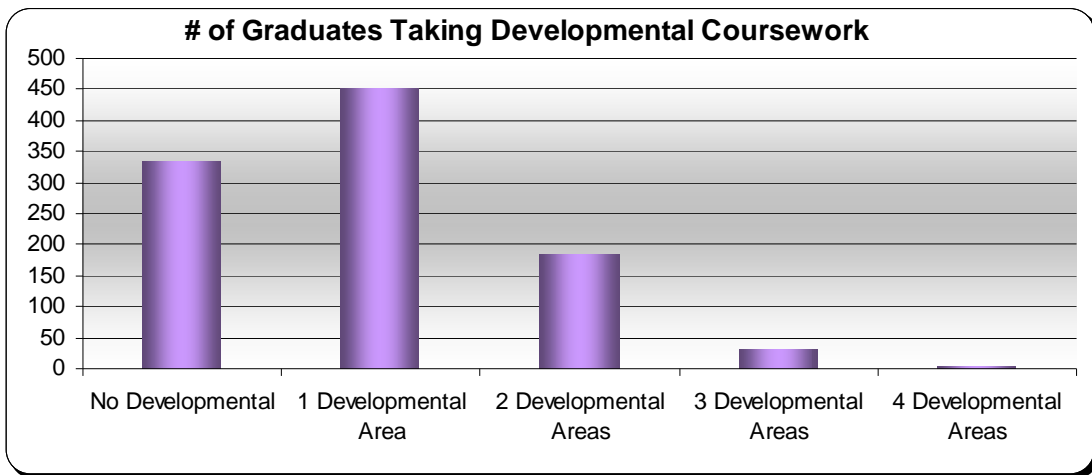

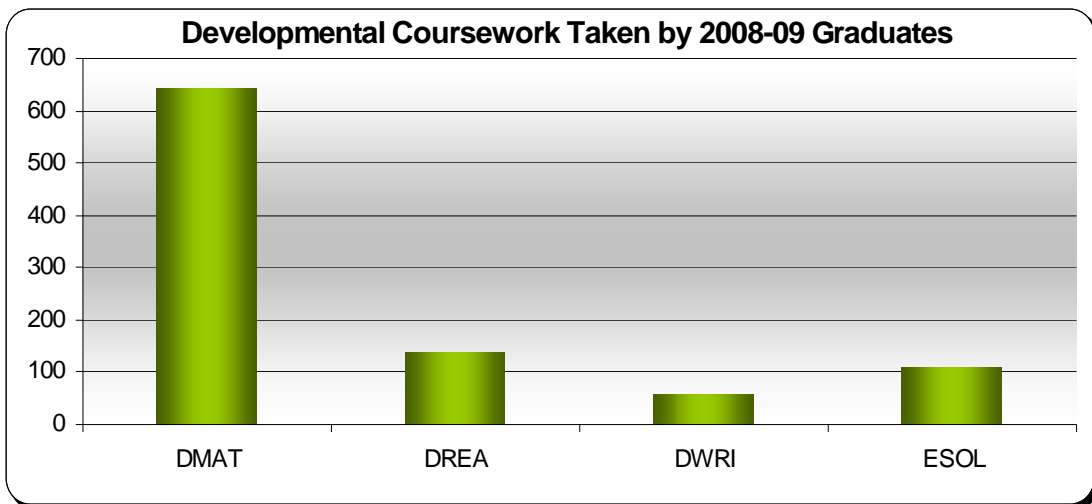
