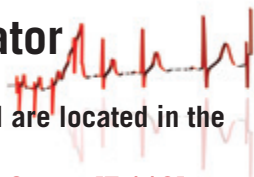


(AED) Automated External Defibrillator

MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION

- ❖ Richland College WILL NOT assume payment for ambulance transportation.
- ❖ Individuals refusing transportation by ambulance (Dallas Fire - Rescue) are solely responsible for the decision. An individual can not be forced to accept medical assistance.
- ❖ Individuals refusing ambulance transportation to a medical facility will be responsible for their own transportation to a medical facility, (i.e. friend, family member).
- ❖ Should faculty, staff of the DCCCD or student decide to transport an individual, that faculty, staff or student does so under personal liability. The (DCCCD) Dallas County Community College District WILL NOT assume responsibility for consequences resulting from such transportation.
