HAZARDOUS SPILLS /OFF-CAMPUS or OUTSIDE THE BUILDING



Because Richland College is bordered on the West and South by designated 'Hazardous Cargo' routes, the chances of an off-campus or near-campus accident or spill affecting campus operations is a possibility. If an off-campus or near-campus spill has occurred, use these guidelines:

- * Follow instructions from authorities and/or Richland College-Emergency Response Team (RC-ERT) members.
- * You may be instructed to shelter-in-place, until the danger passes.
- * You may be instructed to leave campus via restricted or dedicated routes.

The authorities which may be issuing instructions are, but not limited to:

Dallas Fire - Rescue, Dallas Police Department, Texas Department of Public Safety, Richardson Police and Fire Department, in addition to, the Richland College Police Department and Richland College RC-ERT members.
