In addition to opening the new Richland College Garland Campus this spring and the science building and an expanded central plant in the fall, several major projects are under way. On the East Campus, the road to the ballfields will receive a new all-weather surface and a new parking lot will be added next to Kiowa.

A new fire alarm system currently being installed will insure all buildings on campus have the latest sensors and control panels. The panels will feed into a central monitor console in Pecos. Many of the original exterior 'storefront' doors on campus are being replaced this spring which will improve the mag-lock security system.

The GCA custodial crew will implement a 'green cleaning' plan using new methods and supplies. Just north of the warehouse, the "Shops at Pecos" are taking shape which will provide a centralized parts and stores section, campus storage, recycling center and shops.

2009 is shaping up as a year of innovative projects that will improve the Richland College experience.
