MOVE ON!

The movement of employees, furniture and equipment continued all through the month of October. With the Adaptive Remodel of Hondo, Wichita, El Paso and selected rooms in Thunderduck Hall virtually complete... the new walls, carpet, ceilings, lighting, furniture and data provide a greatly improved atmosphere for teaching, learning and community building. With very few exceptions, employees are pleased and excited with the results of this six month demolition and construction process.

Beginning in early November, Campus Police and Facilities Service will move into the expanded Pecos Hall which resulted from funds provided by the DCCCD bond program. Once the furniture and employees are in place, the two departments will work side-by-side to provide uninterrupted service 24 hours a day. Also in early November, the print shop/copy center will be moved to their new headquarters in the northwest corner of Wichita Hall. Expansion of the cafeteria into the E070 conference room is an in-house project set to also take place in November.
