## Words from the Director of Facilities

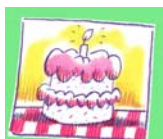

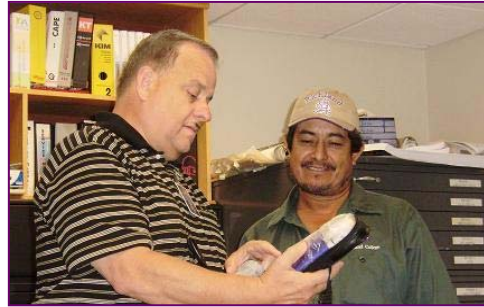
