

DCCCD Retirees Association Scholarship

The DCCCD Retirees Association has a \$500 scholarship, offered through the DCCCD Foundation, for tuition and books to award for the 2010 spring semester. The scholarship is for a deserving DCCCD student who is pursuing the first two years of a 4-year academic degree; students do not need to demonstrate financial need to apply. Please pass this information to students who meet the eligibility requirements and are interested in applying.

- Eligibility criteria**
- * Applicants must have completed at least fifteen (15) academic transfer hours with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.
 - * Applicant must meet the Dallas County residential requirements for tuition.
 - * Applicant must enroll for a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours at a DCCCD college during the Spring 2010 semester.
 - * Applicants are not required to demonstrate financial need.

Application process Applicants must submit the following to the DCCCD Foundation Office by **Thursday, October 1:**

- * Completed DCCCD Foundation Scholarship Application form. Forms are available in the campus Financial Aid Office or at www.foundation.dcccd.edu/scholarships/scholarships.html. (Please write "Retiree Scholarship" across the top of the form.)
- * One-page typed essay clearly detailing future academic goals and future career plans.

- Selection process**
- * The selection will be made by a committee of retired DCCCD faculty.
 - * The winner will be announced by Friday, December 4. (Student may reapply if he/she maintains a 3.0 GPA or higher on 12 credit hours of course work per semester.)
