YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS A PLAYER

1. Know when and where you play.
2. Be dependable - don't let your team down.
3. Be there on time with your student ID card.
4. Know all the rules, you are responsible for them.
5. Respect and abide by the decisions of the game officials.

PLAYER CONDUCT

Profane language, taunting, baiting or any other verbal harassment (talking trash) is an automatic unsportsmanlike conduct penalty or technical foul. The player is automatically ejected upon receiving a second unsportsmanlike penalty or technical foul. The game will be forfeited when one team receives a total of 3 unsportsmanlike penalties or technical foul.

NOTE: Verbal misconduct by players or spectators will not be tolerated no matter the intent or direction of it. Using vulgarity, ridiculing, pointing a finger, making obscene gestures, or any manner of taunting or baiting an opponent is a great disservice to an INTRAMURAL PROGRAM and such infractions will be penalized. IF a player is disqualified, they may not play in another intramural game until he is reinstated by the Intramural Director. To be reinstated, the ejected player must meet with the Intramural Director to discuss Intramural policy. Upon reinstatement, if a player is ejected from another Intramural contest, he or she will be banned from all Intramural activities for the remainder of the academic semester. Also, the players name and ID # will be forward to the proper college authorities for further investigation into school policy violations. All decisions on school suspension and probation will be decided by the appropriate administrators.

Fighting by any player is automated disqualification from the game. Any fighting or physical violence will be treated as an assault crime and referred to the Campus Police for future investigation. Players involved will have their names and ID # sent to the Athletic Director and Campus Dean responsible for student conduct. Decision on college suspension or probation will be decided by the appropriate administrator.

ELIGIBILITY

All players must be students, faculty, or staff of Richland College.

To be eligible to play, you must be on your team roster and must read and sign this player contract. Rosters and contracts must be completed and signed before your team's second league game.

NOTE: All players must show a valid current semester student ID card to prove eligibility status.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Intramural sports at Richland is a voluntary activity in which no one is required to participate. The individual player accepts the risk of injury for any Intramural activity he/she enters. Richland

College, the Physical Education Division or the Director of Intramurals assumes no responsibility for any injury received during an Intramural activity. First Aid will be given at the spot, and the person will be taken to the college Health Services Center for treatment if necessary.

RELEASE OF RESPONSIBILITY

I, the undersigned, hereby release and discharge Richland College, its agents, employees and officers from all claims, demands, actions and judgments which I may have, or claim to have, against the above parties, for all personal injuries and injuries arising out of Intramural Sports Competition.

I have no physical condition that would prevent me from participating in this program. I am in good health and physical condition. I understand the dangers involved in this type of competition.

Richland College may use and reproduce my name, voice likeness and any and all photographs, sketches and motion pictures taken or made of me during intramural participation for any purpose whatsoever.
