

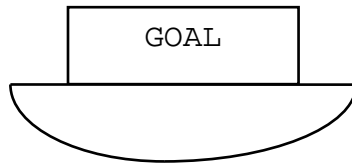

**INTRAMURAL CO-ED INDOOR SOCCER RULES**

1. **PLAYERS** - A team plays five field players and a goalie. Four or five men and one or two woman. The minimum to start a game is four players. Adds and deletes are allowed up until the start of the third game, after which the rosters are frozen. During games, players substitute while the flow of the game continues. Each team may use a transitional player as an extra attacker or defender.
2. **FREE KICKS** - all free kicks are direct kicks.
3. **PENALTY BOX** - Penalties are called and time is served in the penalty box for serious fouls, unsporting conduct (yellow card-two minute penalties), and violent conduct (red card-five minute penalty and ejection). If a player is given a time penalty, that players team must play one man short on the field for the allotted time (the other team is thus in a power play situation). The player serving time in the box may re-enter the game either when his penalty time expires, or when the other team scores, whichever comes first.
4. **PENALTY KICKS** - A two minute penalty is called and a breakaway penalty kick is awarded to a team when a defender intentionally commits a major offense against an attacker in the penalty area. The penalty kick is taken as a one-on-one with the goalie. The ball is placed on the blue line with an attacker. All other players line up on the other side of midfield. The referee blows the whistle and the attacker and the rest of the players start attacking. Inadvertent fouls inside the penalty area results in a direct kick from the blue line, not a penalty kick.
5. **BLUE LINE FOULS** - A blue line violation is called when a pass crosses both blue lines in the air without being touched by another player or the wall. Change of possession and a direct kick from the first-crossed blue line restarts play.
6. Male score counts one point, female score counts two points. Transitional players score counts three points.
7. There is **no slide-tackling** allowed. A two minute penalty will be given and if violent, game ejection (red card.)
8. Games are 16 minutes running time (two 8 minute halves) and start at 12:30, 12:48, 1:06, 1:24, 1:42, 2:00
9. Reminder - Referee judgment is final. Please do not argue over calls. Play for fun and enjoyment.

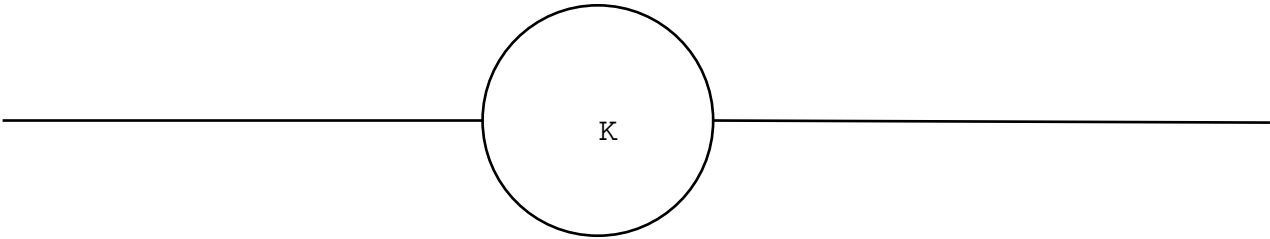

PENALTY AREA

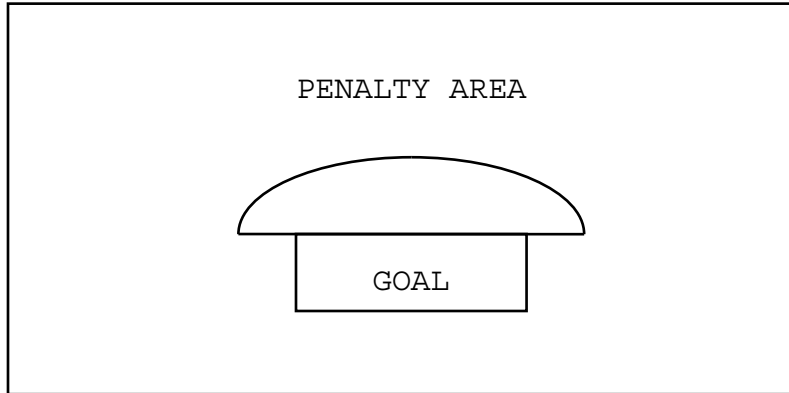
BLUE LINE
