The Richland College Library Liaison program was created in order to connect full-time and part-time faculty with librarians and library resources. Resources include our hard-copy reference and circulating books, our online databases and library website, and our information instruction classes.

A liaison librarian is assigned to work with each academic department. Just a few things that Richland librarians can do for you and your students include offering information literacy classes, locating and suggesting material that supports course work, helping to identify reliable online resources, and giving ad-hoc demonstrations of the research databases to which we subscribe. We also create discipline- and course-specific web-based research guides called LibGuides (<http://libguides.richlandcollege.edu>).
