DEFINITIONS OF PROBATION, SUSPENSION, DISMISSAL, INDEFINITE DISMISSAL
Acceptable Scholastic Performance is the maintenance of a GPA1 of 2.0 or higher

Probation 1

Students who fail to maintain a GPA of 2.0 are placed on Probation 1. Students on PROB1 may have course work and total number of credit hours limited and may be required to register for specific courses. Students on PROB1 must complete at least one credit course in their next semester and earn a semester GPA of at least a 2.0. Students will remain on PROB1 until their cumulative GPA1 is a 2.0 or higher.

Suspension

Students on PROB1 will be placed on Suspension if they fail to complete at least one credit course and earn a GPA of 2.0 for each semester enrolled. Students new to SUSP are required to sit out for one semester (Fall, Spring, or Summer) from the end of the semester in which they went on suspension. Upon their return these students will need to apply for re-admission by meeting with a suspension advisor. For re-admission information go to:

Probation 2

After sitting out for at least one semester, students re-admitted after Suspension will be placed on Probation 2. Students on PROB2 will have course and total number of credit hours limited and may be required to register for specific courses. Students on PROB2 must complete at least one credit course in their next semester and earn a semester GPA of at least a 2.0. Students will remain on PROB2 until their cumulative GPA1 is a 2.0 or higher.

Dismissal

Students on PROB2 will be placed on Academic Dismissal if they fail to complete at least one credit course and earn a GPA of 2.0 for each semester enrolled. Students new to DISM are required to sit out for twelve months from the end of the semester in which they went on DISM. Upon their return these students will need to apply for re-admission by meeting with a suspension advisor. Probation 3

After sitting out for at least twelve months, students on Academic Dismissal will be readmitted on Probation 3. Students on PROB3 will have their course work and total number of credit hours limited and may be required to register for specific courses. Students on PROB2 must complete at least one credit course in their next semester and earn a semester GPA of at least a 2.0. Students will remain on PROB3 until their cumulative GPA1 is a 2.0 or higher.

Indefinite Dismissal

Students on PROB3 will be placed on Indefinite Academic Dismissal if they fail to complete at least one credit course in their next semester and earn a semester GPA of at least a 2.0. Students new to Indefinite Dismissal will be required to sit out for at least twelve months from the end of the semester in which they went on IDIS. Upon their return these students will need to apply for re-admission by meeting with a suspension advisor. For re-admission information go to:
